Exporting Election Results to Microsoft Word .doc Files

You can use the powerful export features of the Integra Election Reporting Console to share information by exporting it from the console to a Microsoft Word .doc file format.

To Export Election Results to a Microsoft Word File

- 1. From the main Election Console page, select the election and contest that you wish to be the subject of your report.
- 2. Select the view and select any filters that you want to use to narrow the information that is included in your report.



Exporting Election Results to Microsoft Word .doc Files (cont.)

The report is generated in a Microsoft Word window. The following .doc file is a sample of one such report for the 2008 Presidential race.
